- <u>ddb10 PhD IP Assessment Form</u> Completed by PhD students in the Engineering and Built Environment, Health Sciences and Science faculties for the protection of Intellectual Property.
- <u>ddb11 Declaration and Submission Form</u> Completed by a PhD student when submitting their thesis for examination.
- <u>ddb12 Examiner recommendation on examination</u> Completed by an external examiner when making a recommendation on the examination of a thesis.
- <u>ddb12a Examiner recommendation on re-examination</u> Completed by an external examiner when making a recommendation on the re-examination of a revised thesis.

- <u>ddb13 Turnitin plagiarism declaration</u> Completed by a PhD student and their supervisor when submitting their thesis for examination.
- <u>ddb14 Confidentiality on the nomination of examiners</u> Completed by a PhD student and their supervisor at intention stage.
- <u>ddb15 Checklist for inclusion of publications in a PhD thesis</u> Completed by the CoA Chair when determining a student's contribution to publications that they intend to include in their thesis.
- <u>Declaration for inclusion of publications</u> Completed by a PhD student who has been granted permission by the Doctoral Degrees Board to include publications in their thesis.

  Completed by a PhD student when listing the revisions made to their revised thesis in response to the examiners' comments/ criticisms, after receiving a Result (iii) outcome.
