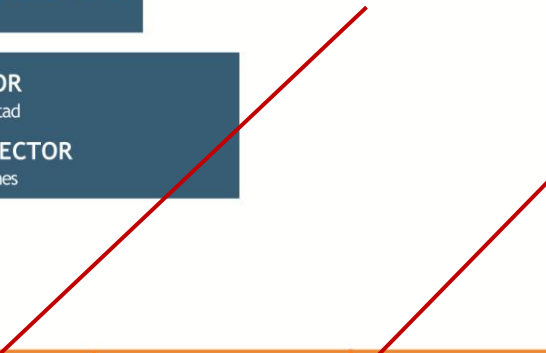

Organisation and work requirements

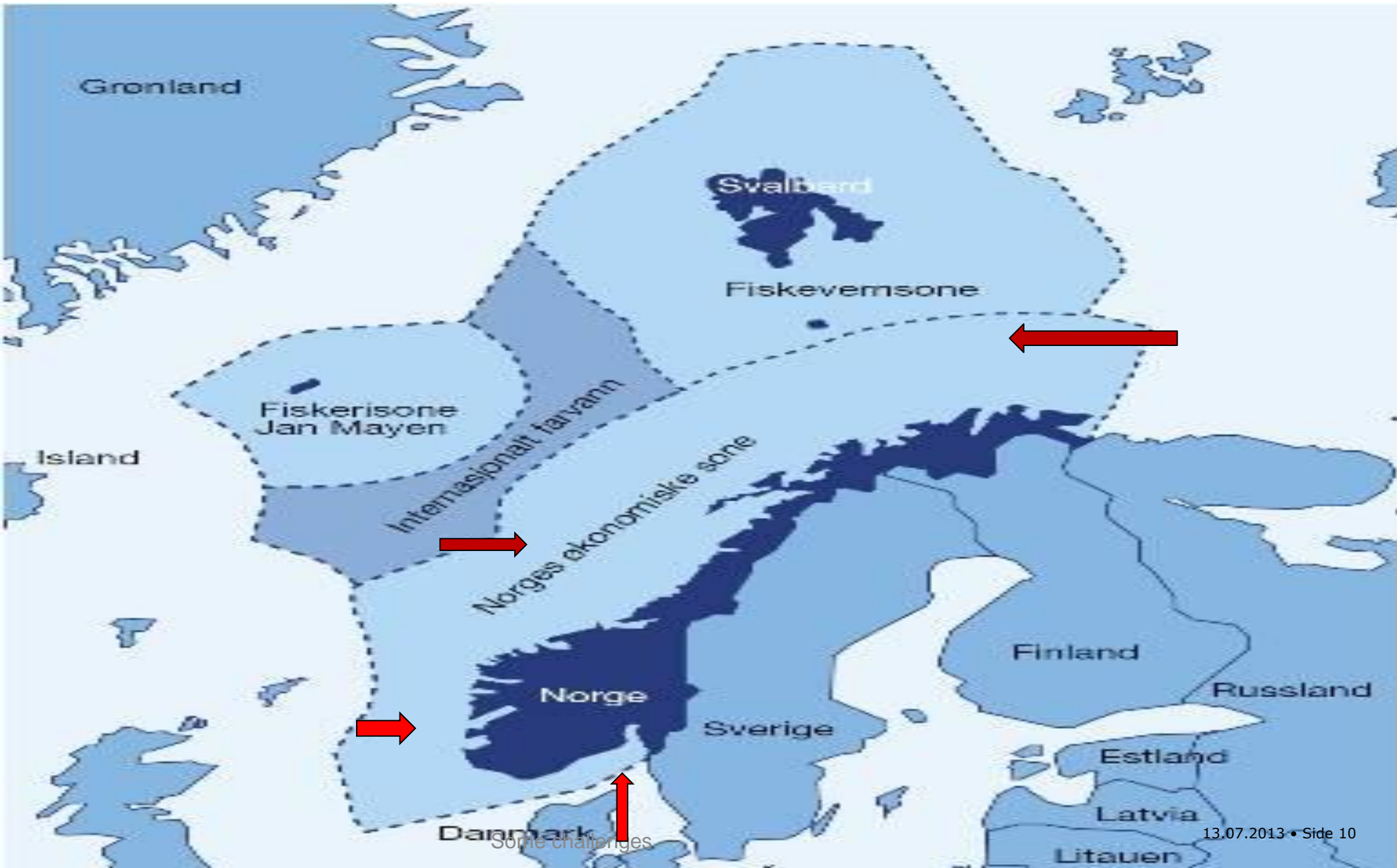
- The program is part-time

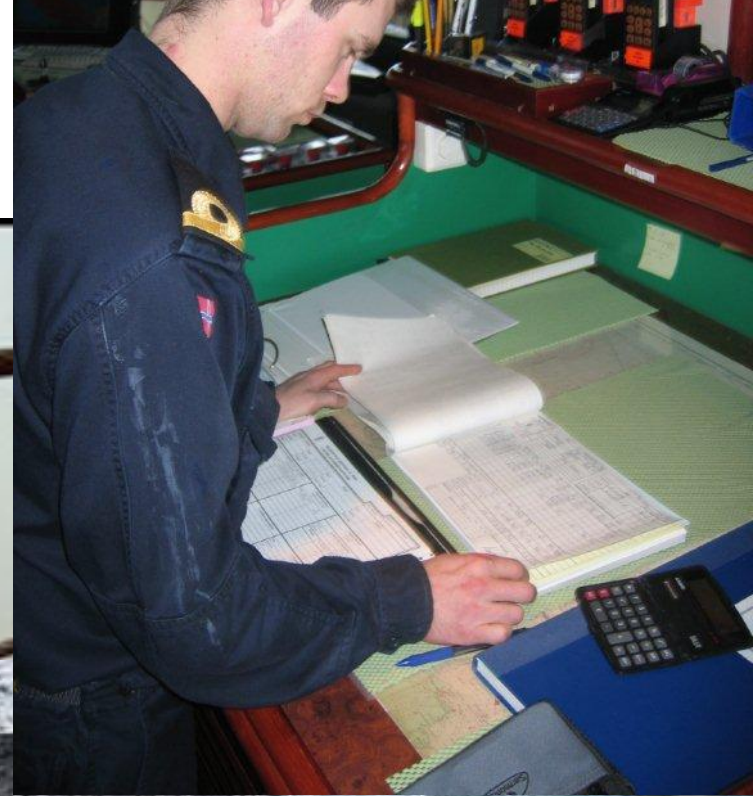
Main subject

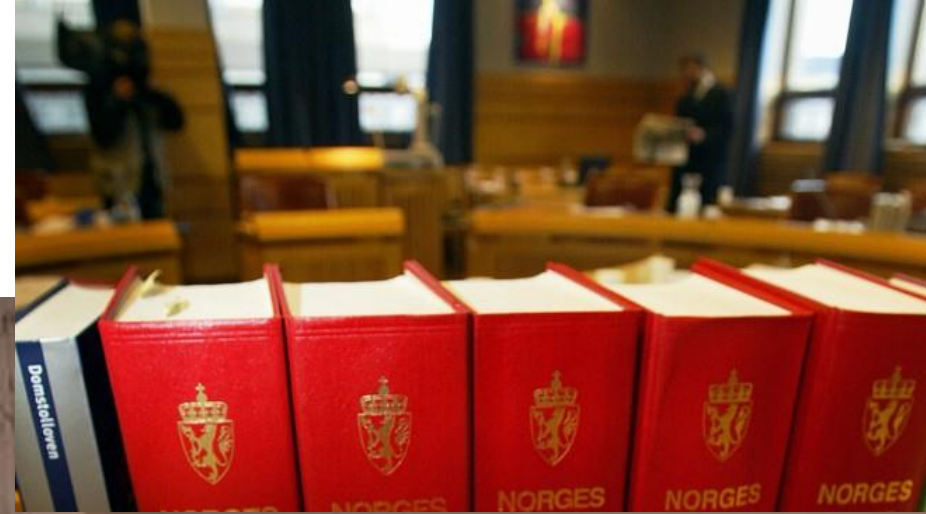
The main theme deals with uncovering fishery crime, securing evidence and investigating it during the fishing and during the landing.
