

Professor Kembreab Habtemichael

Professor Habtemichael obtained his JD at the University of Addis Ababa (Ethiopia) and LLM at Georgetown University in the US. He was the Dean of the Faculty of Law and professor of Contract Law at the University of Asmara, Eritrea. He has been a visiting academic in many universities, among which are University of Trento (Italy), University of Macau (China) and University of North Carolina (USA). Professor Habtemichael is part of the Mineral Law in Africa (MLiA) project led by Prof Hanri Mostert, where he co-ordinates the Eritrean chapter. He is also a practising lawyer in Eritrea. He was one of the African scholars who participated in the inaugural Comparative Law in Africa workshop launching the CCLA in 2012.

His research areas are Contract Law, Constitutional Law, Taxation and Mining Law.
