## 7. Deadlines for Submitting Proposals, Panel Proposals and Full-Text Papers:

Proposals should be submitted for a 20-minute presentation delivered in Chinese or English. The deadline for submitting proposals is Jan. 30<sup>th</sup>, 2012. The deadline for submitting full-text papers is Aug. 15<sup>th</sup>, 2012. Proposals and panel proposals (300 characters maximum), and full-text papers should be sent to worldrhetoric@163.com. CRSW will select excellent papers to be compiled in the journal of the Society for publication after the conference. Please do not submit

your paper to other journals if you want it to be considered for publication by CRSW. If you plan to publish your paper elsewhere, please keep us informed in advance.

#### 8. Date for Sending Relevant Notices:

Acceptance of proposals will be sent by March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2012. The formal conference invitation will be sent by April 15<sup>th</sup>, 2012.
