Dear Alumni and Friends

The Faculty of Law is able to be the outstanding institution that it is only with the support of our alumni and friends. This support comes in so many forms, including (amongst many others) giving guest lectures, serving as adjunct professors, providing networking opportunities and career advice to students and, of course, contributing financially in support of the Faculty's work.

When we conceived of the Faculty's Endowment Fund back in 2008 our priorities were clear-cut. Our needs-blind admissions policy meant that a large majority of our students come from families unable fully to support the cost of their Law studies. Our fundraising for the past decade has therefore focused on assisting with the cost of tuition fees.

In 2018, when the National Student Financial Assistance Scheme (NSFAS) began funding full-cost tuition, the needs of students from the poorest families were largely addressed. However, a large number of students still required additional support for key costs related to doing a Law degree, and we had to review our funding criteria by looking far more closely at academic excellence.

And then 2020 caught all of us by surprise. Our world has changed, and how we assist our students has changed in ways that we could not have thought possible in a world before Covid-19 and lockdown. Our funding needs now encompass more crisis support, unanticipated travel costs, and finding ways of supporting students in a remote learning model.


