Dr Onyinyechi Lilian Uche is an Associate Research Professor at the Nigerian Institute of Advanced Legal Studies, where she teaches Research Methods, Legislative Drafting, Human Trafficking, and National Security. She holds an LLB from Abia State University, an LLM from the University of Jos, and earned her PhD in Environmental Law from the University of the Western Cape, South Africa.

Her research focuses on environmental law with a specific interest in plastic waste regulation, legal frameworks for sustainability, and their relationship with intra-African trade. She is particularly engaged with the legal and policy implications of environmental degradation for regional commerce and governance in Africa.

Dr Uche combines doctrinal legal research with policy-oriented work, contributing to debates on environmental governance, sustainable trade, and human security. She is a Nigerian citizen and continues to contribute to legislative and research initiatives that enhance legal capacity in both environmental and trade sectors across the continent.
