

## **Dr Tebogo Lefifi**

Dr Tebogo Lefifi teaches Chinese Law and Investments in Africa at the University of Cape Town, where she convenes an LLM course and an executive development programme. Her academic qualifications include a PhD from the University of Cape Town (2023), an LLM in Chinese Business Law from the Hong Kong Open University, and a BCom from the University of KwaZulu-Natal. She has also completed advanced training in finance and economics.

Her research focuses on international business strategy, China-Africa economic relations, and regulatory frameworks governing investments and special economic zones. She brings extensive experience from both public and private sectors, having previously served as a senior government official responsible for establishing the first official nation brand agency in China. In that role, she promoted South African and African commercial interests and facilitated Chinese investment and market access initiatives.

Dr Lefifi has held several advisory positions for China-Africa initiatives. She serves on the advisory boards of the Africa China Law Desk and the China-Africa Wildlife Conservation Council, among others. She co-founded the Sino-Africa Centre of Excellence (SACE), which developed the China Business Perception Index across African countries. Her advisory engagements also include roles with Yale University's Visiting Women's Executive Exchange Program and the South Africa China Business Association.
