Dr Yakubu Nagu teaches Law, Regional Integration and Development in Africa (LRIDA) at the University of Cape Town, South Africa, where he is engaged in research on African trade governance, international trade law, and economic development. A Nigerian citizen and an Olu Akinkugbe Business Law in Africa Fellow (2021 cohort), Dr Nagu is an alumnus of the University of Abuja (LLB Hons) and is admitted to the Nigerian Bar. He holds an LLM in International Trade Law and a PhD in Commercial Law from the University of Cape Town.

His doctoral thesis interrogated the African Continental Free Trade Area (AfCFTA), proposing an enabling framework for its implementation using case studies from Ethiopia, Kenya, and Nigeria. Drawing on Lee's General Theory of Law and Development, he developed the Analytical Law and Development Integration Model (ALDIM), a theoretical tool for evaluating the developmental potential of regional integration agreements among African states.
