Call for Papers

The 2024 edition of the *Journal of Democracy, Governance and Human Rights in Zimbabwe* is calling for abstracts. The 2024 edition will accept papers tackling any issues of contemporary significance in the fields of democracy, governance and human rights relating or with implication to Zimbabwe.

Abstracts should be no more than 200 words and should be submitted to justice.mavedzenge@uct.ac.za copying mkika@llm17.law.harvard.edu no later than **15 July 2024**.

An editorial panel will review and select the successful abstracts, after which authors will be informed to proceed to research and draft their full papers. Selected authors will be required to submit their draft papers which must be no more than 8000 words by 15 August 2024. Writing style guidelines will be provided to the authors by the journal editors.

In the typical fashion of the Journal, an in-person seminar will be held, during which authors will have an opportunity to present their draft papers and receive feedback from experts and practitioners. Thereafter, authors will submit their revised papers to the editors for peer review and possible publication in the Journal.

The 2024 edition will be published November.

Now in its third edition, the Journal of Democracy, Governance and Human Rights in Zimbabwe is published by the University of Cape Town's Democratic Governance and Rights Unit in partnership with the University of Zimbabwe Faculty of Law. The journal provides a platform for established and emerging academics and practitioners to examine contemporary democracy, governance and human rights issues in Zimbabwe, and contributes towards building thought-leadership and a body of knowledge in advancement of Zimbabwe's constitutional project. The 2024 edition is edited by Dr. Justice Alfred Mavedzenge and Dr. Musa Kika.
