 - Applicants must be willing to be based in Cape Town for the duration of the scholarship.
 - If not South African, or a permanent resident in South Africa, applicants must have (or be applying for) a valid study permit.

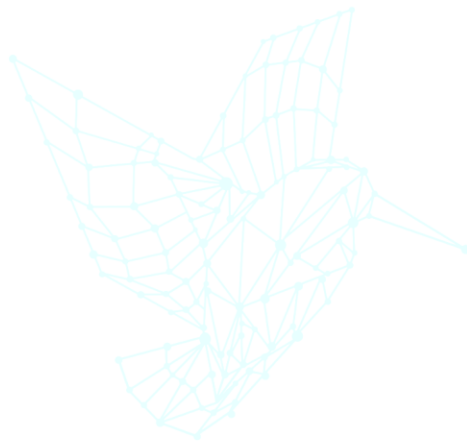
APPLICATION CHECKLIST

2. A cover letter with motivation (one page or less) for the application, outlining your legal interests, including clear indications of an interest in Law & Technology. This motivation must also address your suitability for the research assistant role.
3. A full CV.
4. Two written references from contactable referees.
5. Copies of all academic qualifications.
6. Mid-year academic results and/or academic transcript of previous degree.

*Please note that any application that does not include all of these items **submitted as a SINGLE pdf** will be considered incomplete and therefore invalid.*

NOTES:

1. **Please submit by email to law-marketing@uct.ac.za by 15 October 2024**, along with your most recent academic transcript.
2. Late and/or incomplete applications will not be considered.
3. Scholarship payments are made directly into a student's fee account.
4. Please note that should you receive other funding support, it is possible that your scholarship award may be reversed, or the university may adjust any other university support you receive. Any other funding support would need to be declared to the Law Faculty.
5. Applicants shortlisted for this scholarship may be called to an interview (30 mins), which could be conducted online.
