POPIA gives effect to the right to privacy as set out in the Constitution - it provides the regulatory framework within which organisations may process personal information, thereby giving individuals control over how their personal information is used or disclosed.

In essence, POPIA applies to the processing of personal information of a data subject by or on behalf of a responsible party. This course will discuss the grounds for lawful processing and will focus on material aspects of the act.

The course will benefit lawyers, legal advisors, principal officers, trustees, fund administrators, fund consultants and anyone else interested in data privacy law.
