

COURSE INFORMATION

The course aims to unpack the new Two-Pot retirement system which came into effect on 1 September 2024 and to provide insight as to its implementation.

This course will cover: the law; how it worked before – resignation, retrenchment, retirement; reasons for the changes; the laws giving effect to the Two-Pot retirement system; the changes – savings pot, vested pot and retirement pot; funds included in the new regime; funds excluded from the new regime; members over 55 on T-day; GEPF; emigration; taxation of benefits; treatment of tax debt; impact on treatment of permissible deductions - Section 37D (employer debt, maintenance, divorce, housing loans); impact on death benefits; and examples.

The course would benefit trustees, fund consultants, fund administrators, legal advisors, and attorneys.
